TRASH PICK-UP OR NO TRASH PICK-UP...THAT WAS THE QUESTION!

Due to the recent confusion around the July 4th Holiday Weekend, the following guidelines will be used to determine trash pick-up surrounding a holiday weekend:

1. If a holiday falls on Saturday or Sunday, we will have a regular trash pick-up on Monday and recycling on Tuesday.
2. If a holiday falls on a Monday trash pick-up will be on Tuesday and Recycling will be on Wednesday.
3. If a holiday falls on a Tuesday, trash pick-up will be on Monday and recycling will be on Wednesday.

These rules will remain in effect unless otherwise notified by Oakdale Borough.

Any alterations to this schedule will be posted in the Oakdale Borough Times well in advance of the change.
