

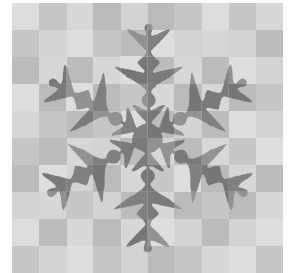
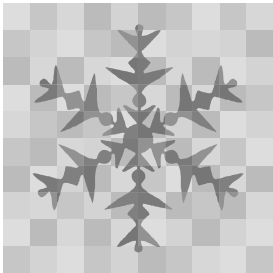

### MESSAGE FROM CHIEF JIM LAURIA

The Oakdale Police manage traffic at the intersection of Noblestown Road and Union Avenue for about three hours per day five days per week. We see so many driving related issues that there are too many to even mention. Some are very funny, some are not so funny and are just dangerous. Please let this serve as a reminder to all drivers. There are hundreds of “winter driving” tips that you can get from the net, Penn Dot, and police; here are the most serious issues we are seeing in this snowy time:

- You must clean off your entire vehicle of snow and ice. This allows you to see better and it keeps the snow from flying off of your car and onto the vehicle behind you. Your blowing snow, mixed with road dirt, oils, and brine can cause the car behind you to be almost driving blind. I am sure this has happened to you.
- As you are cleaning off your car, clean off your headlights. When there is heavy snow the lights become covered and it is impossible to see you coming. This is very dangerous for you and your passengers.
- When your windshield wipers are being used, you must have on your headlights. Some lights are not automatic and have to be turned on. If your vehicle is a darker color and it is evening or early morning with rain or snow in the air and your lights are not on, you may be impossible to see by other motorists. Your lights should be on by dusk and off well into daylight and if it is overcast, leave them on.

Not only are the roads slippery, icy, and snow covered, people are driving through town way too fast and on their cell phones. All of those things are distracting and being on the phone just takes you out of what is happening around you. If you **MUST** be on the phone while driving, for safety's sake, don't do it in the midst of a snow storm or pull over somewhere safe!

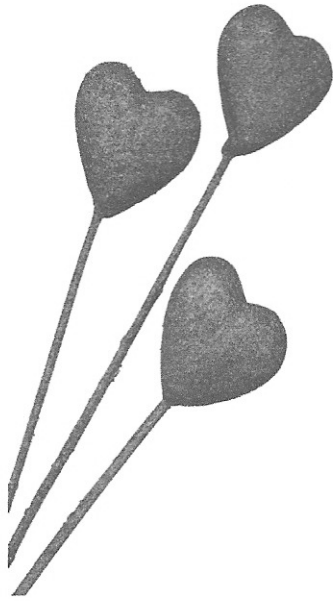
