Request for Bids
Notice to Garbage and Rubbish Contractors

Sealed bids will be received for the Hauling and Disposal of Garbage, Rubbish, Bulk Waste, and Recyclables from residential units, multi-family units and commercial units in the Borough of Oakdale.

Notice is hereby given that specifications and proposal forms are available Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., at the Oakdale Borough Building located at 6115 Noblestown Road Oakdale, PA 15071. The Borough will furnish copies of the bid specifications and forms to prospective proponents upon payment of a Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollar fee.

Bids will be received at the Oakdale Borough Building until 3:00 p.m., prevailing time on June 2, 2021. Bids will be opened in public on June 2, 2021, at 3:15 p.m. in the Oakdale Borough Building. A **MANDATORY** Pre-bid Conference is scheduled for May 19, 2021, at 10:00 a.m. in the Oakdale Borough Community Center located at 104 Seminary Avenue, Oakdale, PA 15071.

Proposals must be submitted on the Official Bid Form. All blank spaces must be completed and no other markings are to be made thereon. All Bids must be signed.

The Borough explicitly reserves the right to reject any and all bids in whole or in part and waive any formalities. Each bid shall remain firm for a period of sixty (60) days.

Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Bond or a Certified Check made payable without conditions, in the name Borough of Oakdale in the amount no less than ten (10%) percent of the first annual contract amount. All bids must be sealed, identified with the name and address of the bidder and clearly marked in the lower left corner of the envelope, "Bid for Garbage and Refuse Service."

Award of the Contract may be made at the Board of Supervisors Meeting to be held at 7:00 p.m., June 3, 2021. The Contract is to commence July 5, 2021.

Detailed specifications provided hereafter, are and shall be considered a part of the contract.

It is the bidder's responsibility to make a complete inspection of the Borough of Oakdale in order to be familiar with all conditions under the bid, and to assure the Borough said contractor will be able to fulfill the contract upon signing.

Each bidder shall provide either evidence of ownership or evidence of a non-cancelable agreement covering use of the disposal area for a period coinciding with the initial Contract year through the end of the Third year option year. Such evidence shall accompany each bid.
