- Motion to adopt Resolution 12-2023 appointing Campbell Durant as the Borough pension counsel.

The new software for billing and processing payments is in effect. MuniLink offers a wealth of information to residents online. You can pay your bill, check your balance, check your usage, update information and so much more on the new website. "NCR – Pay Your Bill" is the link you will find on oakdaleborough.com to pay your bill. Please access the borough website to set up your account information to link bank accounts, credit cards, online bill pay, and pay your bill. Payments will be effective a lot sooner than on the old Doxo Payment system, but please make sure your payment is received BY the 20<sup>th</sup> of the month. **Please note: The office will no longer provide receipts for payments.** You will find your receipt online or use your check as confirmation. If you choose to continue to write checks, please drop them off in the Drop Box outside the office or in the Green Basket in the office.

MuniLink will also provide updated information to you via, email, text, or phone calls, such as water breaks, emergency notifications and other essential community information. Please make sure your contact information is typed in correctly on your account set up page and call the office to update information as it changes.

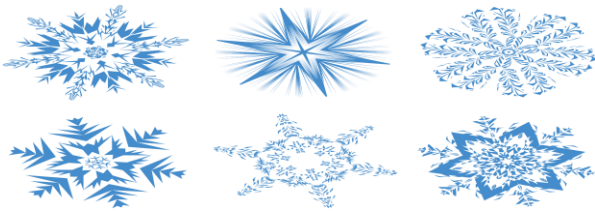

## Valentine's Day Sweetheart Breakfast


