July 26: 11am – 12pm

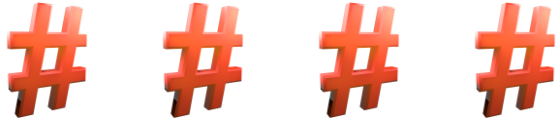
August 14: 11am – 12pm
