JVS CANNOT accept: vacuum cleaners, disposable batteries, and television tubes outside the casing.

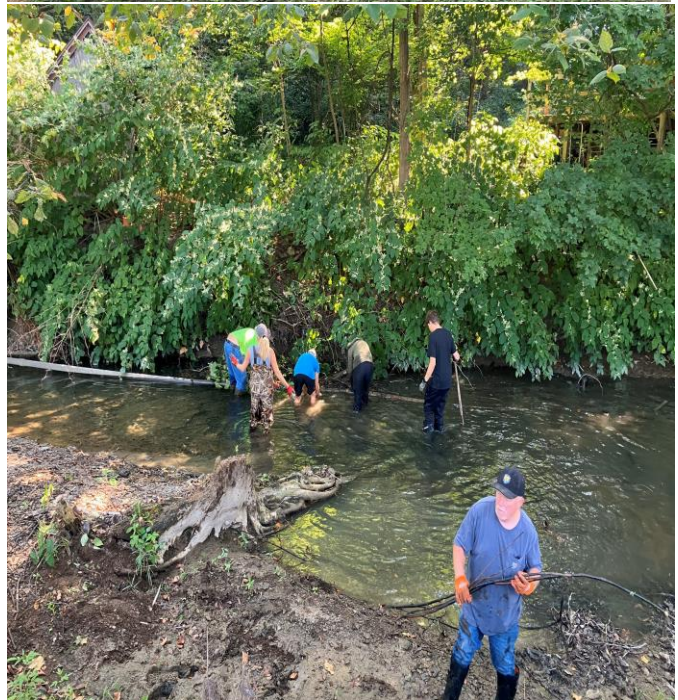
Fireman's Battle of Barrel
