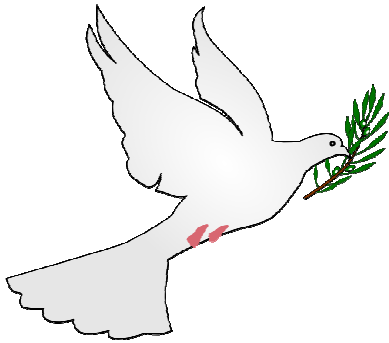

What a year! This holiday season caps off 12 months of first and fun, and the speed bumps along the way.

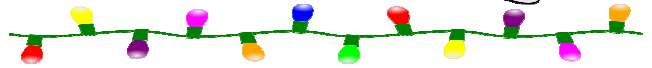

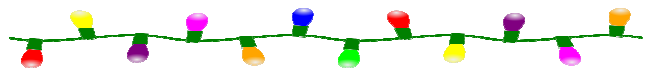

November Council Meeting Update:

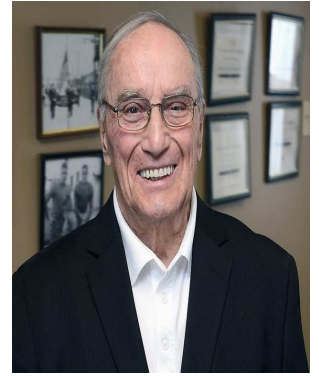
- ❑ Mr. Tom Potts made a motion to pass Oakdale Borough Resolution No. 16-2017 authorizing the filing of an application for CDBG funds with the Allegheny County Economic Department in the amount of \$34,100 to place a cement walkway along the third base line to the bleachers and concession stand in the Borough Park.
- ❑ Mr. Tom Potts made a motion to pass Oakdale Borough Resolution No. 17-2017 adopting a Source Reduction Study as required by the Phase I Consent Order and Agreement with Alcosan.
- ❑ Mr. Jonathan DeBor made a motion to hire Peter Candrea and Robert Staaf as part time police officers for Oakdale Borough.
- ❑ Mr. Jonathan Debor made a motion to advertise an ordinance governing occupancy permits in Oakdale Borough.
- ❑ Mr. Bill Hartman, Jr. made a motion to advertise an ordinance to approve the trash/recycling contract with North Fayette Township.
- ❑ Mr. Bill Hartman, Jr. made a motion to pass Oakdale Borough Resolution No. 18-2017 authorizing a trash and recycling increase of \$1.50 per month.
- ❑ Mr. Bill Hartman, Jr. made an announcement that Light Up Night will be Saturday, November 25, at 7:00 pm.
- ❑ Chief Lauria reported that there were 98 varied police calls in October.

Our next Monthly Borough Council Meeting is scheduled for Thursday, December 7, 2017, at 7:30pm at the Oakdale Community Center. Mayor and Council will be available to answer questions and to receive your input.

- ◆ If a holiday falls on a weekday, your trash will be picked up one day later than normally scheduled.

For example - Thanksgiving is on a Thursday- Everyone who gets picked up on Monday through Wednesday will be picked up on their normally scheduled day. Customers who are scheduled for Thursday pick up will be on Friday and for those who are scheduled for Friday pickup - you will be picked up on Saturday.

HELP US CONTACT YOU!!

Oakdale maintains an Emergency Contact System that can be used to reach out to residents with an informational telephone message in various crisis situations, including Flooding, Water Alerts, and other threats to Community Safety. The System initially contains Home (Main) Telephone Number data from Oakdale Borough's Water/Sewage/Refuse Customer Records, and has been updated in cases where residents have provided information using the Emergency Information Sheet (previously mailed to Residents, and available on the Borough's Website).

We strongly encourage residents to submit a completed form if you have not already done so, or if your contact information has changed. (Please note that some W/S/R Customer Records do not contain a Telephone Number!) The information can be submitted by printing, completing and delivering the form, which can be found on our website, or by clicking on the SwiftReach Portal Link and completing the on-line form. In the event of a critical situation such as a boil water alert, we can only contact you with information/instructions if your current contact number is in our system! 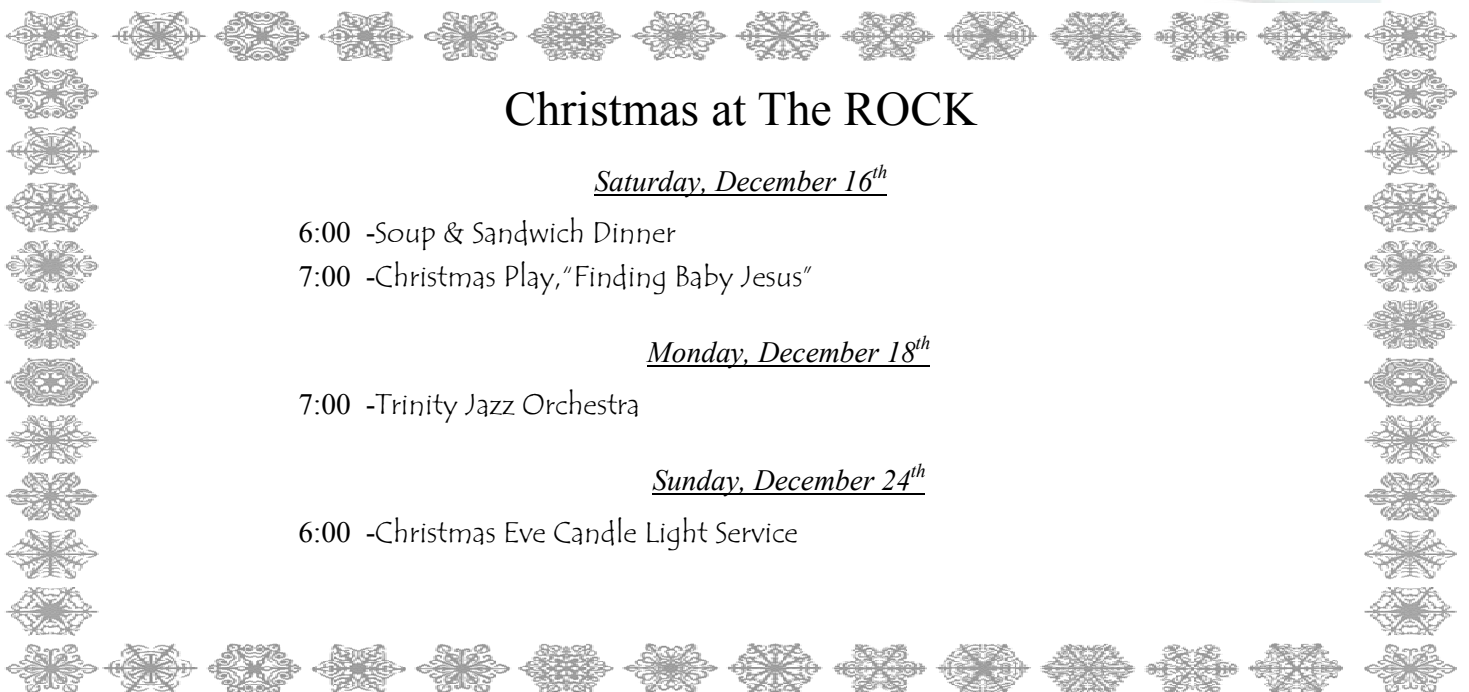


"Dan Hanczar Christmas Orchestra will be performing a mini-concert at Oakdale UP Church on Sunday morning, December 17 at 11 AM.
