## October Council Meeting Update:

- ❑ Mr. Jonathan DeBor made a motion to pass Oakdale Borough Ordinance No. 2017-4 amending part 2 licensing of transient retail businesses, section 201 thru 209 of the Borough Code of Ordinances.
- ❑ Mr. Jonathan DeBor made a motion to approve an Inter-Municipal Agreement with North Fayette Township to collect trash and recycling for Oakdale Borough.
- ❑ Mr. Jonathan DeBor made a motion to hire James Corr as a part time police officer.
- ❑ Mr. Jonathan Debor made a motion to approve Change Order No. 1 for the First Street Waterline Project in the amount of \$14,604.62.
- ❑ Mr. Jonathan DeBor made a motion to approve payment request no. 3 for the First Street Waterline Replacement Project in the amount of \$30,009.44 to Border Patrol.
- ❑ Mr. Albert Pifer made a motion to approve the subdivision of the Fountain Plan as recorded in P.B. Volume 6, pages 197 & 198 also known as the Boy's Home Apartments.
- ❑ Mr. Al Pifer reminded everyone that the Halloween Parade will be at 5:30 pm and Trick or Treat will follow from 6 to 8 pm on October 31.
- ❑ Chief Lauria reported that there were 90 varied police calls in September.
- ❑ A Cottonwood Ave. resident voiced his concerns of speeding on Cottonwood Dr. Council and Chief Lauria agreed to start giving out warnings and tickets to help slow down the drivers.
- ❑ A resident voiced his concerns regarding the new smart meters that West Penn Power is going to start installing in Oakdale Borough.
- ❑ Mark Snatchko reported that the Firemen's Fair was a success this year. Upcoming fundraisers include another purse bingo, a pasta dinner in November and another boot drive. A new roof was put on the firehouse and the men's bathroom was remodeled. They did not get the grant they applied for a new fire truck. Want to work with the Borough's grant writer for 2018 grants.

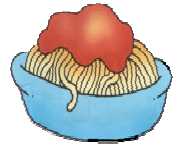
