RESOLUTION NO. 9-2026

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH OF OAKDALE, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING THE ANNUAL CRITERIA THAT A VOLUNTEER MUST MEET TO BE CERTIFIED UNDER THE BOROUGH OF OAKDALE VOLUNTEER SERVICE CREDIT PROGRAM TO CLAIM LOCAL TAX CREDITS AND APPROVING THE MEMBERS SUBMITTED TO THE BOROUGH FOR TAX CREDIT.

WHEREAS; pursuant to Act 172 of 2016 (35 Pa. C.S.A. § 79A01 et seq.), governing incentives for municipal volunteers of fire companies and nonprofit emergency medical services agencies, municipal governments are authorized to grant local tax credits to active volunteers of fire companies and nonprofit emergency medical services agencies; and

WHEREAS; on April 4, 2019 the Council for the Borough of Oakdale enacted Ordinance No. 3 of 2019 establishing a Volunteer Service Credit Program and authorizing local tax credits against tax liability imposed by the annual tax on real estate and the annual tax on earned income as levied by the Borough of Oakdale, as incentives for the use and benefit of certain individuals who are qualified and certified as active members of the volunteer fire department; and

WHEREAS; Section 324-60(B) of the Ordinance requires the Council of the Borough of Oakdale to establish, by resolution, the annual criteria to qualify for tax credits under the Volunteer Service Credit Program; and

WHEREAS, the Oakdale Volunteer Fire Department have certified that the Volunteer Firemen identified by each application for Volunteer Service Tax Credits and incorporated as Exhibit "A" have met the qualifications to be eligible for the Volunteer Service Credit Program; and


Section 3. Municipal Approval. The Manager for the Borough has reviewed the applications for credit under the Volunteer Service Credit Program and cross referenced them with the notarized eligibility list. After review, the Council approves the volunteers that appear on the notarized list submitted pursuant to Section 324-60(F) of the Borough Code of Ordinances.

Section 4. Repealer. Any resolutions of the Borough of Oakdale inconsistent herewith are repealed to the extent of said conflict.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective as of January 1, 2026 in accordance with Section 324-60(D)(2) of the Borough Code of Ordinances.


