ROAD CONSTRUCTION AHEAD — Raise your hands on who loves the challenge of finding a new way to work or home? We have been told that STATE ROUTES 978 & 3048 ARE FINALLY GETTING PAVED.

Penndot has scheduled the paving of Clinton Avenue (SR978) and Noblestown Road (SR3048) to start the week of August 1. Clinton Avenue will be paved from Oakdale Road to Union Avenue and Noblestown Road will be paved from Gormley Avenue to Union Avenue. OK, not be the bearer of bad news, but these roads are so heavily traveled, the work will be done from 6:00 pm to 6:00 am. Detours will be posted as necessary. Other work that will be done during this project include, catch basin repairs, manhole cover replacement as needed and valve repairs.

- Council President, Mark Maximovich, called the meeting to order.
- Mayor Hennemuth led the Opening Prayer.
- Jonathan DeBor made a motion to approve General Code to codify Oakdale Borough's Ordinances at an estimated cost of \$10,000 billed over a two year period.
- Bill Hartman, Jr. made a motion to approve the 2017 audited financial statements prepared by our auditor, Mark C. Turnley.

- Bill Hartman, Jr. made a motion to approve the replacement of the fire escape stairs on building 1 and renovate the kitchen in apartment 2 of building 3.
- Al Pifer announced that the Oakdale Hose Company's Annual Street Fair starts July 21 with free entertainment every night. The parade will be held Friday, July 27 at 7:00 pm.
- Chief Lauria reported that there were 115 varied police calls in June.
