BOROUGH UPDATE

NOVEMBER BOROUGH COUNCIL MEETING UPDATE

- Council President, Huck Gamble, called the Meeting to Order.
- Mayor Paul Hennemuth led the Meeting with a Prayer.
- Mr. Jonathan DeBor made a Motion to appoint Northwest EMS as the Emergency Ambulance Service for Oakdale Borough.
- Mr. Jonathan Debor made a Motion to hire Sydney Stangl as a part-time Police Officer.
- Mr. Tom Potts made a Motion to pass Oakdale Borough Ordinance No. 2016-1, increasing the indebtedness of Oakdale Borough by issue of a Guaranteed Revenue Note in the amount of \$340,495, for Pennvest Loan to replace First St. Waterline Project. The Interest Rate for years 1 thru 5 will be 1.387% and years 6 thru 20 will be 2.001%.
- Mr. William Hartman, Jr. made a Motion to approve the purchase of a 2011 Chevy Impala Police Car from Woltz & Wind Ford for \$4,000.
- Mr. William Hartman, Jr. announced that Light Up Night will be on Saturday, November 26, at 7:00 pm at the downtown Gazebo, followed by refreshments compliments of The Rock and the Masons, along with a visit and photos with Santa at The Rock.
- Oakdale Hose Company President, Mark Snatchko, asked Council to consider helping with the purchase of a new Fire Truck when preparing the 2017 Budget.
- A Resident of Maple Ave had some questions regarding the paving of Maple Ave.
- Chief Lauria reported that there were 110 Police Calls in October.


