Arthur James Russ, Jr. was born in Oakdale on February 20, 1921, and passed away on October 30, 2015.

Jim served as a Radio Operator in the Army Air Corps with the OSS during WWII. Following his years of employment with Blue Cross Blue Shield of Western PA, he took over Crow Insurance Agency in Smithfield PA and made a great success of it! He retired to Florida in 1983, and then moved back to Fayette County to be near family until his final years, when he lived at the Goodwill Mennonite Village in Grantsville MD. He was married to Alice Russ for 69 years, and they have two children, Daniel Humphries-Russ and Darcy Miller.

One of the enduring joys of Jim's life was his long friendship with Ralph Keenan - also a native of Oakdale. He and Ralph were friends for over 90 years; a friendship that began and was nurtured right here in Oakdale!

THEN AND NOW

Did you know that in the early days, Willow Avenue was Oakdale's "Main Street?" And did you know that the main thoroughfare from Willow to State Street (now Noblestown Road) was a Bridge between what is now the Karate Studio and Business Legal ('The Bank Building)?

The original State Street Bridge washed away in the 1904 Flood, and had been replaced with an iron and wood structure, which was quickly becoming unsafe due to years of increased automobile traffic. The Project to rebuild the Bridge in its current location was initiated by Borough Council in 1919, and was completed in 1921.

If you or someone you know is in need of help with their Taxes, consider the VITA Program this Tax Season. The Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) Program is offered free to qualifying individuals. IRS-Certified Volunteers provide basic State and Federal Income Tax Return preparation with electronic filing. Volunteers will prepare State and Federal Taxes BY APPOINTMENT ONLY (NO WALK-INS) during February, March and April.

All interested Residents should call or stop by the Western Allegheny Community Library **beginning January 11** to schedule an Appointment. *Please call early to be assured of an Appointment. You may schedule an Appointment prior to receiving the required Tax documents. - Own a Business
