- Mr. Tom Potts made a Motion to approve Change Order No. 1 of the 2015 Stream Channel Repair Project in the amount of \$22,786.55 per the recommendation of our Borough Engineer, Rob Arnold.
- Mr. Tom Potts made a Motion to approve Payment Request No. 2, in the amount of \$48,276.17, from Martino, Inc. for work completed on the 2015 Stream Channel Repair Project per the recommendation of the Borough Engineer, Rob Arnold.
- Mr. Bill Hartman, Jr. made a Motion to pass Oakdale Borough Resolution No. 1-2016 to adopt the Allegheny County 2015 Hazard Mitigation Plan as the official Hazard Plan of the Borough of Oakdale.

TEMPORARY CHANGE IN WATER TREATMENT PROCESS

As part of our distribution system (pipeline) maintenance program, Pennsylvania American Water will temporarily change its disinfection treatment process at our Pittsburgh water treatment plants from chloramine (combined) residual to free chlorine residual. Weather permitting the change will take place between March 14, 2016 and April 18, 2016. During this time period, PAW also will be flushing the distribution system. Customers may notice an increase in the taste and smell of chlorine in the water as a result of the change. Discolored water may also occur during flushing in your neighborhood. This is normal and will only be temporary while we complete this system maintenance. Thank you for your patience while we complete this important annual maintenance program.


