Leaves and other yard waste should be placed in garbage bags marked "Leaves." Tree Branches may not be more than 2" wide. We encourage you to mulch or compose grass clippings whenever possible.

BOROUGH UPDATE

APRIL BOROUGH COUNCIL MEETING UPDATE

- Council President, Huck Gamble, called the Meeting to order.
- Mayor Hennemuth led the Meeting with a prayer.
- Mr. Mark Maximovich made a Motion to accept RAT, LLC Property and Consolidation Plans and Applications as complete.
- Mr. Mark Maximovich made a Motion to approve 2015 Stream Channel Repair Project Change Order No. 2 in the amount of \$13,241.79, per the recommendation of our Borough Engineer, Rob Arnold.
- Mr. Mark Maximovich made a Motion to approve Payment Request No. 4 in the amount of \$18,779.63, from Martino, Inc. for work completed on the 2015 Stream Channel Repair Project, per the recommendation of the Borough Engineer, Rob Arnold.
- Mr. Tom Potts made a Motion to advertise for Bids for the 2016 Oakdale Paving Project. The number of Streets that can be paved this year will depend on the Bid amounts.
- Mr. Tom Potts announced that the next Borough Event will be the Great American Cleanup on Saturday, April 23rd, from 9:00am until noon. Volunteers are asked to meet at the downtown gazebo area at 9:00am.
- Mayor Paul Hennemuth reported that there were 62 Police Calls in March.
- Tom Robinson and his Representatives discussed the progress of the Brewery Project and other property issues with Council.

- Consult with the Borough Office to determine whether Ordinances//Regulations are in place that will affect your Plans.
- Apply for Permits, as needed, BEFORE beginning your Project.
- Make sure that you know Property Lines, when building/constructing close to your Property's Border.
- Call "811" before digging...!
- DO NOT bury/cover Water Lines and Sewer Lines, including Valves and/or Curb Boxes. (It may become necessary to break up a driveway in order to access a leaking Line!)
